# STAINLESS STEEL WIRE BRUSHES

#### DESCRIPTION

This brush features strong stainless steel bristles in a smooth shaped wooden handle. Used to reduce the risk of contaminating a stainless steel weld, these brushes are available with 2, 3 or 4 rows.



#### INFORMATION

These products are used in the cleaning of parent metal in preparation for welding, and to sweep away weld slag and spatter after welding.

Weldability offer 2/3/4/5-row wire brushes in two models; a mild steel bristled version and a version with stainless steel bristles. The latter is used to greater reduce the chances of a stainless steel weld becoming contaminated.

The long handled converging bristle models are useful for providing greater access to hard-to-reach weld areas.

### NOTES

Weldability carry a wide range of wire brushes, including 2, 3, 4 and 5 row mild and stainless steel bristled models, 2, 3 and 4 row stainless steel long handle brush and a 3-row converging wire brush.

Part numbers with suffix 'HQ' indicate that these brushes are of a higher more durable quality, while 'HD' specifies 'Heavy Duty'.
